FROM THE POLICE.

ALL owners of dogs are enjoined within the ending of January month to procure from the Police Office (for Kingshill District from Kingshill Police Station) the signs for dogs prescribed by the Police Regulations, which according to same must always be worn by the dog, and for which Francs 10.00 must be paid for dogs in town and Francs 2.00 for dogs in the country.

After said time dogs met not wearing the sign for 1921 will be caught and brought to the Police Office (Kingshill Police Station) and detained for 3 times 24 hours, when it will be killed, unless the owner appears to claim the dog, pays a fine of Francs 15.00 and eventually procures the required sign.

GOVERNMENT OF THE VIRGIN ISLANDS OF THE UNITED STATES ST. THOMAS.

24 December, 1290.

Sir:

In accordance with the recommendation submitted by the Export Tariff Commission, composed of yourself as Chairman and Messrs. R. L. Merwin, F. Andersen, A. Lang, C. V. F. Daniel as members, which Commission met at Frederiksted, 23 December, 1920, the Governor approves the valuations and directs that the export duties be collected beginning 6.00 a. m., 1 January, 1921 as follows:

MOLASSES...	3%	on valuation of 1 Frc. per gallon,
RUM.....	3%	" " " 5 " " "
COTTON.....	5%	" " " 125 " " 100 lbs.
COTTON SEED.	3%	" " " 5 " " "

IT is hereby made known that the Horse, Carriage and Boat Tax for the first half year 1921 will be received by the Policemasters in Christiansted and Frederiksted from the 20th January to the 10th of February 1921, both days included, after which the list of arrears will be transmitted to the same authorities for further measures.

Each debtor of tax will be subject to a fine Francs. 1.00 if the tax be under Francs. 25.00 and Francs. 2.00 if the tax be Francs. 25.00 or above, beside the ordinary levy expenses.
