Dear Judge Brothman:

The Fourth Amended Case Management Order entered by Your Honor on September 27, 1993, set a discovery deadline in these consolidated cases of December 1, 1993. Shortly before that date, Exxon/Esso filed a joint motion to extend that deadline to the complete collection of certain empirical data. That motion was supported by a Certification of Thomas F. Maguire, C.P.G., Esso's hydrogeologic consultant. This motion was orally argued on December 2, 1993, but was not decided by the Court at that time.

Essentially, the motion related to ongoing investigation in the Tutu area, including the site assessment of the Easo Tutu Service Station (RTSS). The installation of monitor wells on the RTSS property as part of this site assessment would provide the first groundwater samples from monitor wells actually located on that site.

Soil analytical results obtained during the installation of these monitor wells, and as part of other excavation activities:

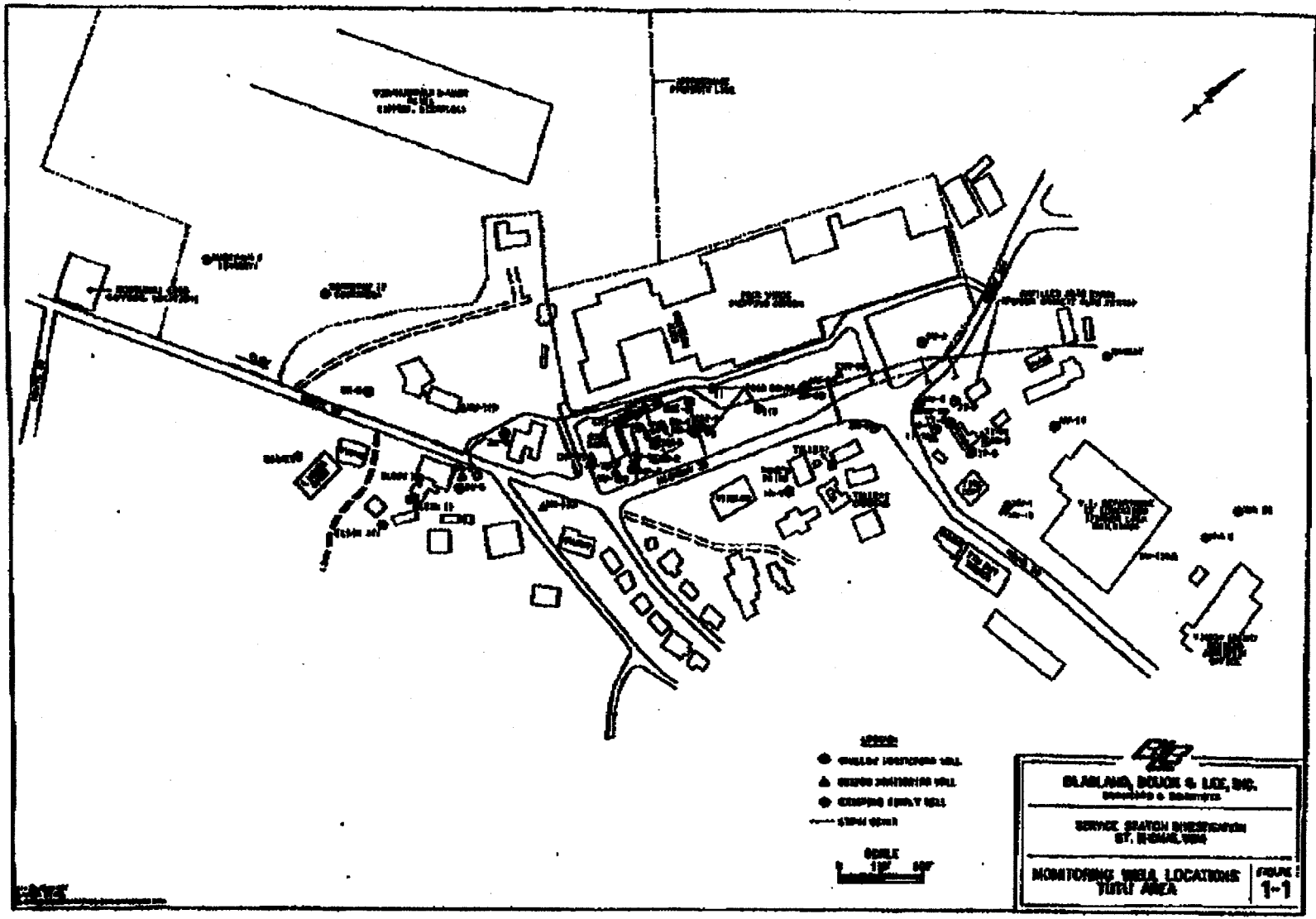
