The Tutu Environmental Investigation Committee (TEIC) is currently implementing a Remedial Investigation (RI) that includes an evaluation of the groundwater quality in the Tutu area. This work is being conducted in accordance with a work plan approved by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA). The sampling activities are being coordinated with the U.S. Virgin Islands Department of Planning and Natural Resources (DPNR).

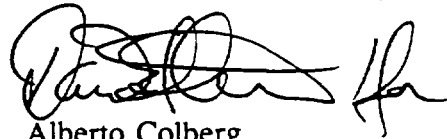

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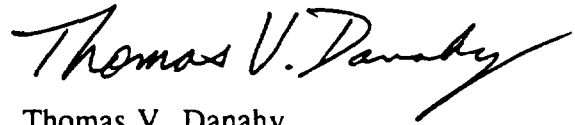

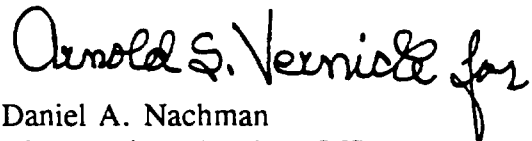
