A Proclamation.

BY virtue of the authority vested in me and in accordance with the practice observed within the United States, MONDAY, MAY 30, 1921, known as MEMORIAL DAY, is appointed a holiday and set aside throughout the Virgin Islands for the purpose of paying fitting honor to those who have given their lives in the defence of the United States and its ideals of liberty, equity, justice and right, the protection of life and the pursuit of happiness.

The usual ceremonies will be observed by the military and naval forces and all persons are invited to participate in honoring the heroic dead.

Witness my hand and the Seal of the Government of the Virgin Islands of the United States at St. Thomas the 20th day of May in the year 1921.
