

MESSAGE

FROM THE

PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES,

TRANSMITTING,

PURSUANT TO LAW, COPIES OF CERTAIN ACTS AND RESOLUTIONS
OF THE NINTH LEGISLATURE, THIRD SPECIAL SESSION, APRIL
26 TO MAY 6, 1920, OF PORTO RICO.

DECEMBER 7, 1920.—Read, referred to the Committee on Pacific Islands, Porto Rico, and the Virgin Islands and ordered to be printed.

To the Senate and House of Representatives:

As required by section 23 of the act of Congress approved March 2, 1917, entitled "An act to provide a civil government for Porto Rico, and for other purposes," I transmit herewith copies of certain acts and resolutions enacted by the Ninth Legislature of Porto Rico during its third special session (April 26 to May 6, 1920, inclusive).

These acts and resolutions have not previously been transmitted to Congress, and none of them has been printed.
