

exactly the same language as Jefferson Davis, and that some of the men who voted for the Irish self determination motion in the United States had ancestors who had fought to the death against conferring to the southern states of America the very demand they were now supporting for Ireland. The acceptance of that demand, declared the Premier, would never come. It was a demand which if persisted in would lead to exactly the same measures of repression as in the case of the Southern States of America, and Great Britain claimed nothing more than the United States had claimed for themselves. Great Britain he added, would stand on her own legs. There was certain powers which might be conferred upon Ireland when he settled down to an established union and accepted partnership with the United Kingdom, said the Premier but if they were given at present, they would be only wasted to the harm of the union and herself, since it would be placing dangerous weapons in the hands of an infuriated people. The Premier concluded by saying that he believed the Bill would result in bringing about a union of the North and South, a union of Protestants and Roman Catholics and a union of Great Britain and Ireland.
