LOCAL.

There will be an ordinary meeting of the Colonial Council today at 1 p. m. Presumably His Excellency, the Governor will attend. The Order of the Day consists of but two items as published, viz: an additional money bill granting the Department of Education an amount of Frcs. 24,124.50 for transfer of the Frederiksted High School and refundment of rents to the Theodore Roosevelt Grammar School of Frederiksted—and introduction and first discussion of a draft of ordinance submitted by 1st member for Christiansted Country District Stake-mann for the restoration and re-establishment of the various commissions, Board of Health, Quarantine Commission, Hospital Commission, etc., etc. It will probably be a lively meeting.

The S. S. "Guiana" for New York is due at Frederiksted on Friday morning the 18th instant. See notice about closing of mails.
