TELEGRAMS.

ST. CROIX STATION.

Brussels, June 17th—Four of the 17 balloons, which took off from Solsbeeck plain in the Gordon Bennett Cup Race on Sunday, were reported down today. They include one American, one Italian, and two British.

London, June 18th—Sugar in stock on the 14th inst was 141,000 tons. Last year 114,000 tons.

Mexico City, June 17th—A brief note issued by the Foreign Office, in regard to the Cummins incident says, "to show the prudential sentiments of the Mexican Government regarding the case of the British subject Mr Cummins, our Foreign Office giving an example of the highest consideration for the Diplomatic Corps, has decided to wait a short period of the result of amicable efforts by the Chilean Minister for the British Government, in order to allow Mr. Cummins to leave. Failing Mr. Cummins departure after a prudent period the order of expulsion will be enforced."

Rome, June 17th.—Sections of the Fascist National Militia have been mobilized, Contingents of Carabinieri have been centred in Rome for the maintenance of order.

Capetown, S. A. June 17th.—In the general elections held throughout South Africa today, Pretorius Smuts was defeated in Pretoria.

Tokio, June 18th—The United States reply to Japan's protest against exclusion of Japanese from the United States is marked by a spirit of friendliness and reasonableness and will be examined in the same spirit, it is authoritatively stated here today.
