Y., a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware, (instruments dated December 27, 1922 and August 7, 1923, and recorded April 10, 1923 and October 10, 1923, respectively), and that the said assignment, with respect to the above mentioned trade-mark No. 45756, has this date been recorded in the Office of the Government Secretary of the Virgin Islands of the United States, at St. Thomas, in accordance with the provisions in the regulations governing the registration of patents and trade-marks in the Virgin Islands, approved June 30, 1920.
