The temporary permit to operate the treatment system requires a minimum of 48 hours notice to be submitted to the Department of Public Works prior to any discharge to the sanitary sewer.

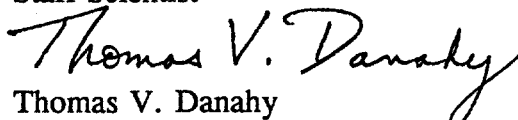

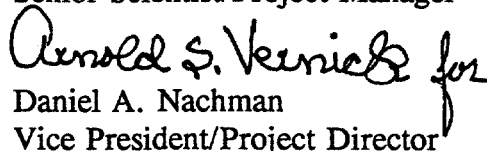
