Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ. Galatians 2: 16.

They will find that God is longing to forgive their sins, and to give them the rest and peace that come from accepting Jesus as their all-sufficient Saviour.

Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins. 1 John 4: 10.

They will find that God in His great love sent His Son to be their Saviour, and that He will hear them when they pray directly to Him in the name of Jesus Christ.

Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give it you. For the Father himself loveth you. John 16: 23, 27.

For there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus. 1 Timothy 2: 5.

They will find that God has sent His Spirit into the world to be the Comforter of sorrowing hearts, and the Teacher who will lead them into all truth.

But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you. John 14: 26.
