

Notice To The Public.

AS a preventative against Small-Pox all school-children will be required to submit to the Principal of their respective schools a certificate of successful vaccination on the first day of the session or upon their admission to the school.

Those children who have been vaccinated may obtain a certificate free of charge at the Christiansted and Frederiksted Hospitals between the hours of 10 and 11 a. m. daily except Sunday.

Those who have not been vaccinated can be vaccinated at the Hospitals at the above specified time.

Furthermore Municipal Physicians will be at the following places at the time specified for the purpose of doing vaccination and issuing certificates.
