IT is hereby brought to public notice that the Ordinance providing for a compiled Code of Laws for St. Croix, as passed by the Colonial Council for St. Croix at its extraordinary meeting held on 17th May 1920, has been sanctioned and approved as follows:

"The hereto attached draft of Ordinance consisting of four titles as follows:

- Title II - Civil Law
- Title III - Civil Procedure
- Title IV - Criminal Law
- Title V - Criminal Procedure,

which was passed by the Colonial Council for St. Croix, on Monday, May 17th, 1920, is hereby sanctioned and approved to take effect and be in full force in all its provisions at and on August 1st, 1920, at 12:01 o'clock a. m.

It is further directed that the Government Secretary place on file for public perusal, copies of this Ordinance, in the following public offices, viz:

The Despatching Secretary's Office,
