TELEGRAMS.

ST. CROIX STATION.

Dominica, Sept. 29th.—At a public meeting held here last night under the auspices of the Chamber of Commerce and the Dominica Representation Government Association resolutions praying for a measure of popular representation on the Legislature and the withdrawal of Dominica from the Leeward Islands Confederacy were passed amidst enthusiasm. Queues lined the streets leading to the St. Gerrard's Hall where the meeting was held. For hours before the opening of the meeting capacity of the hall proved inadequate within five minutes after the opening of the doors.

London, Sept. 27th.—An outline of the reply of the Russian Soviet Govt. to the note of Lord Curzon calling for the attestation of the Soviet Government to alleged serious breaches of faith in the pursuance of a campaign of intrigue against Great Britain in Central Asia and Afghanistan by the Soviets, has been delivered to Lord Curzon. M. Berzin, of the Russian Trade Delegation, has written Lord Curzon that the Soviet Govt's. reply is being handed to Mr. Robert Hodges, the British trade representative in Moscow. M. Berzin declares that while the Soviets are fully convinced the accusations are without foundation, the Soviet Government is making fresh inquiries, in order to be able to refute the charges in detail, meanwhile, M. Berzin says, no time must be lost in pointing out that many of Lord Curzon's statements "will not bear the most superficial examination". As an instance, he cites Lord Curzon's allegation that Santore Nuerteva, formerly in charge of the movements of foreigners in Moscow, issued a statement as Director of the Department of propaganda under the third international of Moscow on June 20th, "In France", M. Berzin asserts, "he has been in prison since March and never had any position under the third international." Similarly, M. Berzin adds, "other reports attributed to Eliava Karahan (Soviet representative in Warsaw) and others have no foundation in fact. Rothstein, Ambassador of the Russian Socialist Federal Soviet republican in Teheran, never has been engaged in forming revolutionary committees in Persia. De Hafix ever has been sent to Moscow or any other place by the Soviet Government". De Berzin says there is no doubt that Lord Curzon, the British Foreign Secretary, has fallen a victim of false rumours spread by Russian White Guards and of French origin.
