ORDER

GÓMEZ, C.J.

Before the Court is the motion of defendant Z&E, Inc. ("Z&E") to sever the claims of Alan P. Borghi ("Borghi") against Purple Group, Inc., d/b/a Purple Papaya of St. Thomas ("Purple Group") from the claims against Z&E, Inc., d/b/a Purple Papaya ("Z&E"). In support of the motion, Z&E argues that severance is appropriate because it would allow Borghi to proceed against Z&E in St. Croix, while the claims against Purple Group would remain in St. Thomas. That argument presumes that transfer of the

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matter to St. Croix is appropriate with respect to Z&E. However, the Court has already determined that transfer is inappropriate with respect to Z&E. Accordingly, it is hereby

ORDERED that the motion to sever is **DENIED**.
