PARTNERS, HOW TAXED.

Section. 19.—Partners in mercantile or other business, whether residing in the same or in different places, shall be jointly taxed under their partnership name in the place where their business is carried on for all the personal property employed in such business, including ships, vessels, boats, and lighters. If Partners have places of business in two or more assessment districts, they shall be taxed in each of such places for the proportion of property employed therein. When so jointly taxed each partner shall be liable for the whole tax.
