1. Production of Copies of minutes of the Municipal Committee for the quarters ending Jun. and September a. c.
2. Colonial Council Bill No. 49. Introduction of and 1st Discussion on Colonial Council Bill No. 49, Resolution introduced by Government, authorizing the sale by auction, for the highest bid in each case, of Lot No. 15 East Street and Lot No. 36 Fisher Street in the town of Christiansted.
3. Colonial Council Bill No. 50.
