BULL-INSULAR LINE TO HAVE PASSENGER SERVICE.

The Bull-Insular Line is again considering the establishing of a passenger service to Porto Rico, it is understood, and is attempting to charter or purchase vessels suitable for this trade. One of the ships that the Bull-Insular Line has been attempting to take over from the United States Shipping Board is the Moccasin, which was formerly the Hamburg American liner Prince Joackim. This is a ship that the Porto Rico Line made application for some weeks ago but it was later reported that the Shipping Board has decided to put it in the New York South American trade. Recent information is that the ship has not yet been allocated. It is reported that the Bull-Insular Line wants two passenger ships for the Porto Rico service. They will be used for cargo and passenger carrying purposes. —*Porto Rico Progress Oct. 17.*
