Entrance to the Grand Stand \$1, Children 50c.

Entrance to the enclosure \$1.50.

Only members will be allowed to drive their cars or carriages within the enclosure adjacent to the Judge's Stand.

No person shall be allowed to cross the course after the bell has been rung, except during the half hours intermission between the races.
