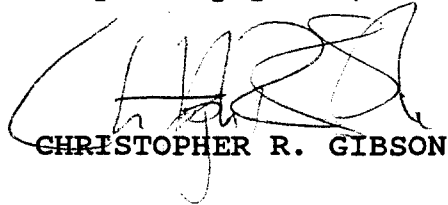
We would like to begin the field work delineated under this Program as soon as possible, and we look forward to your prompt review of this submission.
