As discussed in your April 5, 1994 telephone conversation with Thomas Danahy, we understand that a new Designated Coordinator (DeMaximus) for the Tutu Environmental Investigation Committee (TEIC) has been selected and will soon be under contract and formally appointed. Be assured that Geraghty & Miller, Inc. will provide our continued support to facilitate a smooth transition.

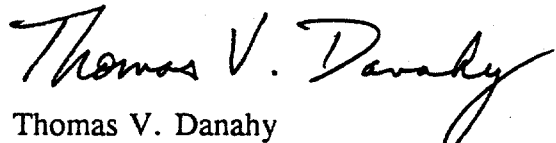
- 1) Should invoices continue to be sent to Texaco and Esso for payment?
- 2) Will DeMaximus give direction to Geraghty & Miller on behalf of Texaco and Esso?

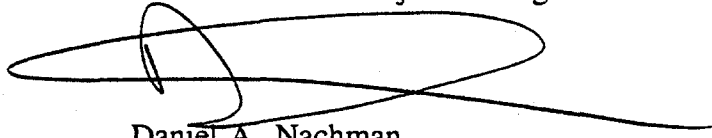
- 3) Will a technical contact at Esso be maintained?
