SERVICE WITH THE LEEWARD
ISLANDS

EFFECTIVE at once the exchange of
money orders between the United
States and the Leeward Islands (em-
bracing Antigua, Dominica, Monserrat,
Nevis, St. Kitts, and Tortola), tempora-
rily suspended in May last, is resu-
med by mutual agreement of the two coun-
tries, and previous notice advising the
suspension of money order business be-
tween the Virgin Islands of the United
States and the Leeward Islands Colony is
hereby modified accordingly.
