A party of 124 Barbadian labourers recently arrived at Barbados, from Cuba, per schooner, being returned immigrants from that place. They are said to be looking so much better than an earlier batch from the same place. Mention is also made of the arrival of the s. s. Remlik, on Sep. 22, with 236 more labourers from Cuba. Of these 250 were Barbadians, 13 to St. Croix, 13 to St. Lucia, 5 to St. Vincent, 2 Montserrat and one to Dominica. The steamer was to make another trip shortly.—*Dominica Guardian Oct. 19th.*

Alcoholic poisoning, caused by drinking bootlegger's whiskey, containing wood alcohol appears to be spreading in the U. S. During the first six months of the year 45 fatalities were reported in New York, 28 in New Jersey, 15 in Pennsylvania, 5 in Texas, and so on. In Pennsylvania wood alcohol killed 61 persons last year.
