Special Conditions required on implementation of Projects:

The current scope of work (PW 01261, Version 0, GM 86987) was developed for costing only; therefore, no NEPA review has been conducted and the project has not been reviewed for compliance with Federal Environmental and Historic Preservation (EHP) Laws and Executive Orders.
