Publication.

It is hereby made known that the Horse, Carriage and Boat Tax for the 2nd half year 1920 will be received by the Director of Police in Christiansted and Frederiksted from July 20 until August 10, 1920, both days included, after which the list of arrears will be transmitted to the Director of Police for further measures. Each debtor of tax will be subjected to a fine of Frcs. 1.00 if the tax be under Frcs 25.00 and Frcs. 2.00 if the tax be Frcs. 25.00 or above, besides the ordinary levy expenses.

The tax lists will be distributed by the Police in conformity with the Ordinance of February 22, 1853, on the 1st of July 1920 to be returned to the Director of Police within 48 hours in the town and 4 days in the country.
