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all proceedings against others, is provided for in a proclamation to be issued tomorrow. An order in council, which was signed late on Saturday by his Excellency the Governor General, makes provision for this general amnesty to military offenders. The order in council based upon a report of Mr. Doherty sets forth the reasons which actuated the Government in deciding this important step. "The Minister observes", says the report, "that it is in his opinion expedient in view of the restoration of peace for the general purposes of re-establishment, that an amnesty should be graciously extended to all such (military) offenders, so that those now undergoing imprisonment, may be discharged so that pending prosecutions for the offenders aforesaid, may be discontinued and so that all offences therefore committed and the penalties incurred and not actually enforced and paid, shall be generally pardoned and forgiven. The Minister therefore, recommends that a proclamation of a general amnesty for offenders be issued in pursuance of the powers in that behalf rested in your Excellency".
