for the 3rd Ordinary Meeting of the Colonial Council for St. Croix, MONDAY, December 13, 1920, at one o'clock p. m.

1. Colonial Council Bill No. 50. 2nd Discussion on Colonial Council Bill No. 50 Draft of Additional Money Bill to the Budget for the Municipality of St. Croix, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1921. Introduced by Government, authorizing the payment of Frs. 60,000.00 from funds in the Municipal Treasury, not otherwise obligated, to the Telephone Fund for the purpose of effecting repairs and new installations.
2. Colonial Council Bill No. 52. Introduction of, and 1st Discussion on Colonial Council Bill No. 52, Draft of Additional Money Bill to the Budget for the Municipality of St. Croix, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1921, Aid to poor of Christiansted and Frederiksted introduced by Government.
3. Colonial Council Bill No. 51. 1st Discussion on Resolution introduced by 4th Appointed Member (Blackwood) authorizing the payment of the unexpended balance of the pension granted former Sicknurse Ritzberg to his widow.
