

BILL NO. 35-0405

Thirty-Fifth Legislature of the Virgin Islands

November 12, 2024

An Act appropriating the sum of \$800,000.00, from the Senior Citizens' Center Revolving Fund, to the Virgin Islands Department of Human Services for the general upkeep of senior centers throughout the Territory

PROPOSED BY: Senator Diane T. Capehart

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:

SECTION 1. (a) The sum of \$300,000.00 is appropriated in the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026, from the Senior Citizens' Center Revolving Fund, to the Virgin Islands Department of Human Services, to be equally distributed to the following senior citizens' community centers for general upkeep: Aldershille Senior Center; Richmond Senior Center; Project Strive Center; Anna's Retreat Senior Center; Adrian Senior Center; and St. Ursula's Senior Center.

(b) The sum of \$500,000.00 is appropriated in the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026, from the Senior Citizens' Center Revolving Fund, to the Virgin Islands Department of Human Services, to be equally distributed to the following senior citizens' community centers for general upkeep: Herbert Grigg Home for the Aged; Queen Louise Home for the Aged; and Lucinda A. Millin Senior Citizens' Homes.

(c) The funds appropriated in subsections (a) and (b) remain available until expended.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill appropriates the sum of \$300,000.00, from the Senior Citizens' Center Revolving Fund to the Virgin Islands Department of Human Services, for the general upkeep of Aldershille Senior Center, Richmond Senior Center, Project Strive Center, Anna's Retreat Senior Center, Adrian Senior Center, and St. Ursula's Senior Center. This bill also appropriates the sum of \$500,000.00, from the Senior Citizens' Center Fund to the Virgin Islands Department of Human Services, for the general upkeep of Herbert Grigg Home for the Aged, Queen Louise Home for the Aged, and Lucinda A. Millin Senior Citizens' Homes.
