Then, there must have been a wrong copy handed to the Council, because I saw the date on the letter of appointment when it was presented to the Council, and I drew the attention of 2nd Member for Frederiksted Country District to it, and he, I believe, will bear me out.

1st appointed Member (*Coulter*) remarked: Mr. Vice-Chairman. The Honorable 2nd Member for Christiansted Town (*Canegata*) is right in his statement. The communication from the Governor to the Council states that my appointment is dated May 10. Perhaps that was an oversight. But my appointment was received by me while I was sick in bed and I showed it to two gentlemen who visited me at the time and particularly drew their attention to the date.
