Madrid, March 3rd.—Reports from the Portuguese frontier declare that the workmen of Portugal have proclaimed a Soviet republic and that postal, telegraphic and other workers have joined the railwaymen in the movement. The news has however not been confirmed.

London, March 3rd.—The Supreme Council is expected to finish its labours as far as the Premier's are concerned, on Saturday. The details of the Turkish Treaty are being left to the conference of Foreign Ministers and Ambassadors. Although the council is silent as to what areas will be allotted to Turkey, it is understood that the subtraction to be made from her territory will decrease her population by three million to six million. This will necessitate the entire re-adjustment of the Turkish debt.

London, March 3rd.—General Deneke's army has been trapped in the Kuban Peninsula, south-east of the Sea of Azov, it is claimed in a Soviet official statement today by wireless from Moscow.

Atlanta, Ga., March 2nd.—Mr. Palmer, Attorney General, has formally announced his candidacy for Democratic nomination for Presidency.
