1. It is hereby brought to public
notice that the Public Schools of the
Virgin Islands of the United States will
be opened on August 8, 1921.

2. All children six years of age or
over must be present at their respective
schools at 9.00 A. M. on that date; non-
attendance, except for legitimate cause
is punishable by a fine imposed on par-
ents or guardians.

3. No child, except in a case of new
arrivals in St. Croix, will be admitted to
school after August 8, 1921, until the
beginning of the School Year in August
1922 unless they can show fitness to un-
dertake the work of a class already
established. Semi annual enrollments or
admittances are discontinued.

Country District (Nelthropp.)

3rd Discussion on Colonial Council
Bill No. 6, Draft of an Ordinance
