IT is hereby made known that the Horse, Carriage and Boat Tax for the second half year 1923, will be received by the Director of Police in Christiansted and Frederiksted from the 20th July to the 10th August 1923 both days included, after which the list of arrears will be transmitted to the same authority for further measures.

Each debtor of tax will be subject to a fine of Fres. 1.00 if the tax be under Fres. 25.00 and Fres. 2.00 if the tax be Fres. 25.00 or above, besides the ordinary levy expenses.

The tax-lists will be distributed by the Police and are to be filled out in conformity with the ordinance of February 22, 1853 and returned to the respective Police Offices within 48 hours in the towns and 4 days in the country.
