Thirty-Fifth Legislature of the Virgin Islands

March 9, 2023

An Act amending title 17 of the Virgin Islands Code pertaining to school curriculum in elementary and secondary schools

PROPOSED BY: Senators Franklin D. Johnson, Alma Francis Heyliger
and Milton E. Potter

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:

SECTION 1. Title 17 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 5, section 41, subsection c is amended as follows:

(a) Paragraph (1), as amended by Act No. 8684, is stricken and a new paragraph (1) is inserted to read as follows:

“(1) The history of the Virgin Islands and basic Caribbean history, such courses to be part of the curriculum in elementary and secondary schools.”

(b) Paragraph (3) is amended by striking “Family” and inserting “Drug prevention and substance education, family” and after “education” by striking “and substance abuse.”

BILL SUMMARY

This bill repeals Act No. 8684 and reinstates the provisions of Act No. 4844 with amendments. The proposed legislation still provides for Virgin Islands history and basic Caribbean history to be taught in elementary and secondary schools.
