IT is hereby made known that the Horse, Carriage and Boat Tax will be payable, for the second half year 1924, at the Police Offices in Christiansted and Frederiksted from July 20, 1924 to August 10, 1924, both days included.

Parties remaining in arrears for this tax after August 10, 1924, will be subject to a fine of Fres. 1.00 if the tax be under Fres. 25.00 and Fres. 2.00 if the tax be Fres. 25.00 or over, besides the ordinary levy expenses.

The tax-lists will be distributed by the Police and are to be correctly filled out in conformity with Ordinance of February 22, 1853 and returned to the respective Police Offices within 48 hours in the towns and 4 days in the country districts.

IT is hereby made known, that the Tax on Auto Vehicles and Auto Truck Trailers according to Section 31 of the Ordinance concerning Public Roads in St. Croix, approved July 14, 1923, will be payable, for the second half year 1924 at the Police Offices in Christiansted and Frederiksted from July 20, 1924 to August 10, 1924, both days included.

Parties remaining in arrears for this tax after August 10, 1924, will be subject to the same penalties as in the case of the Horse, Carriage and Boat Tax.

Tax-lists will be distributed by the Police Department and are required to be correctly filled out and returned to the respective Police Offices two days after receipt in the towns and 4 days after receipt in the country districts.

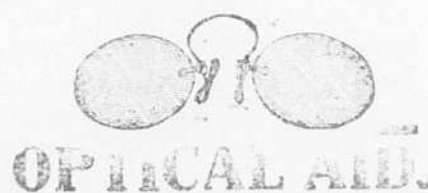
