LS, two Infmen place wire netting over barbed wire across open terrain, other Infmen cross over it.

MS, CU, two soldiers set up range finder equipment in field and relay information over field telephone.

CU, soldiers wearing gas masks receive arm injections.

LS, jeep moves across open road as shells explode nearby; soldiers leave jeep and run onto field.

MS, GIs firing 60mm and 81mm mortars in field.

MS, American flag waves from pole.
