

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the school year 1919-1920 will begin September 8, 1919.

All children six years of age or over must be present at their respective schools at 9 a. m. on that day; non-attendance, except for legitimate cause, is punishable by a fine imposed on parents or guardians.

Children who will attain the age of six years within four months after September 8, 1919, may be admitted to schools on that date when written application of parents or guardians to do so has been approved by the School Director.

No child except in the case of new arrivals in St. Croix, will be admitted to school after September 8, 1919, until the beginning of the school year in September 1920, unless they can show fitness to undertake the work of a class already established.

Semi-annual enrollment r admittances are discontinued, as it will be impossible to admit pupils to a class after the beginning of the school year.

An entirely new set of text-books has been secured, and a new system of teaching in accordance with American methods and ideas, will be established.

All teachers will be required to attend classes in professional subjects on Saturdays and at such other times as the School Director may prescribe.
