for the 5th Ordinary Meeting of the Colonial Council for St. Croix, MONDAY, March 1, 1920, at one o'clock p. m.

1. Colonial Council Bill No. 23.
Resolution authorizing the Governor to increase amounts budgetted for the current fiscal year by a percentage not to exceed that by which the rates of exchange for the current fiscal year exceed the normal rate. Introduced by Government.
2. Colonial Council Bill No. 24.
Resolution authorizing the Governor to sell the parcel of land and building known as East Hill School, situated in East End Quarter A, in the island of St. Croix.
3. Colonial Council Bill No. 24.
Draft of An Ordinance introduced by 1st. Member for Christiansted Country District (Stakeman) respecting the appointment of employees of the Municipality of St. Croix.
4. Colonial Council Bill No. 26.
Draft of an Ordinance introduced by 1st. Member for Christiansted Country District (Stakemann) concerning the remission and refunding of certain taxes assessed or collected on properties used for religious purposes.
5. Colonial Council Bill No. 27.
Interpellation to Government, introduced by 1st. Member for Christiansted Country District, (Stakemann) in regard to the re-opening of the Richmond Sore-foot Hospital.
