Lord Burnham said that he wished to emphasize strongly the need of the national stability here and everywhere, because it was stability the empire stood in need of today. "I don't say let us rest and be thankful", said Lord Burnham in conclusion. He also spoke of the development of trade relations between Canada and the other parts of the empire, and his address was greeted with loud applause by all those who were present at the luncheon.
