1. Colonial Council Bill No. 9.

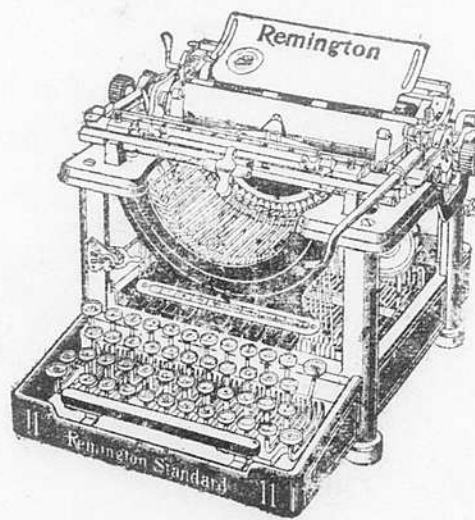
