BUILDINGS TO HALF-STAFF IN HONOR OF
VIRGIN ISLANDS FIRE-FIGHTER DWAYNE THOMAS**

ORDER

The Virgin Islands community mourns the passing of Virgin Islands Firefighter, Mr. Dwayne Thomas. Mr. Thomas served with the Virgin Islands Fire Service for over 22 years. His outstanding service and commitment to the Virgin Islands Fire Service, his fellow firefighters and family will serve as a testament of his love for his profession and his island home, and therefore, it is fitting that all Virgin Islands flags on all local government buildings in the Territory be flown at half-staff until sunset on the date of his interment.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Kenneth E. Mapp, Governor of the Virgin Islands of the United States, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Revised Organic Act of 1954, as amended, do hereby Order that all Virgin Islands flags shall be flown at half-staff at Government House and upon all local government buildings and grounds throughout the Territory until sunset on February 7, 2018.
