PROCEEDINGS OF THE COLONIAL COUNCIL FOR ST. CROIX.

Fourth Council, Second Session, 1924-1925

(Continued from yesterday's Avis.)

Item 5.

Election according to Par. 6 of Ordinance of January 17, 1908, of one member to enter the Board of Management of the Asylum for Lepers.

13 voting tickets were handed in.

2nd Member for Christiansted Town (Canegata) was elected with 11 votes.

3rd Member for Christiansted Country District (Robt. W. Skeoch) and 3rd Member for Frederiksted Country District (M. M. Skeoch) received 1 vote respectively.

Item 6.

Election of 2 men to take part with Government in deciding on the application to be made on the Golden Wedding Legacy of their Danish Majesties the King and Queen.

Election of do. of the Silver Wedding of their Royal Highnesses the Crown Prince and Crown Princess of Denmark.

Election of do. of the Nuptial Fund of His Royal Highness Prince Valdemar of Denmark.

Election of do. of the P. C. Birch and wife Rosaline Antoinette's Legacy.

The Chairman remarked: It had been the custom to take up these four items together and make one election of the same two men for the four legacies.

14 voting tickets were handed in, one was invalid.

Elected were:

For Christiansted:

2nd Member for Christiansted Town (Canegata) with 13 votes.

For Frederiksted:

1st Appointed Member (Coulter) with 10 votes.

1st Member for Frederiksted Town (Jackson) received 3 votes.

A recess of 20 minutes was given.

The Council reassembled after recess and the Chairman brought up item 7.

Item 7.

Election of four (4) members for the Commission pursuant to paragraph 1 of Ordinance of 20th September, 1911, regarding measures against diseases of cotton plants.

13 voting tickets were handed in, one was blank.

Elected were: D. S. Armstrong with 11 votes, W. H. Clarke with 10 votes, W. H. MacKay and F. Andersen with 8 votes respectively.

Item 8.

Election according to Title V. Chapter 12, Section 4, of the Code of Laws for St. Croix of a Jury Commissioner.

14 voting tickets were handed in, one was blank.

Elected was 2nd Member for Christiansted Town (Canegata) with 12 votes.

2nd Member for Christiansted Country District (Berg) received 1 vote.

Item 9.

Election pursuant to Paragraph 3 of Ordinance of 18 January, 1913, of two (2) members to serve on the Public Village Commission.

13 voting tickets were handed in.

Mr. A. Hoffmann was elected with 10 votes.

1st Member for Christiansted Town (Abramson) received 7 votes, 1st Member for Christiansted Country District (Jessen) 4 votes, 4th Member for Frederiksted Country District (Andersen) 3 votes, 2nd Member for Christiansted Country District (Berg), 3rd Member for said District (Robt. W. Skeoch) and 1st Member for Frederiksted Town (Jackson) 1 vote respectively.

As none of the others had requisite majority vote a new free election had to take place for another member.

14 voting tickets were handed in.

1st Member for Christiansted Town (Abramson) was elected with 11 votes.

1st Member for Christiansted Country District [Jessen] received 2 votes and 1st Member for Frederiksted Town [Jackson] 1 vote.

Item 10.

Election according to Paragraph 64 of the Colonial Law of two men to frequently examine the cash in the Treasury of the Municipality of St. Croix and to appoint an auditor according to Resolution of December 12th., 1918.

13 voting tickets were handed in.

3rd Member for Christiansted Town [Alexander] was elected with 8 votes.

4th Member for Frederiksted Country

District [Andersen] received 6 votes, 2nd Member for Frederiksted Town [Merwin] 4 votes, 2nd Member for Christiansted Town [Canegata], 3rd Appointed Member [Armstrong] and 1st Member for Christiansted Country District [Jessen] 2 votes respectively, 1st Appointed Member [Coulter] and 1st Member for Frederiksted Town [Jackson] 1 vote respectively.

As none of the others had absolute majority vote a new free election had to be taken for another member.

13 voting tickets were handed in.

4th Member for Frederiksted Country District [Andersen] was elected with 8 votes.

2nd Member for Frederiksted Town [Merwin], 1st Member for Christiansted Country District [Jessen] received 2 votes respectively and 1st Appointed Member [Coulter] 1 vote.

Item 11.

Election in conformity with Section 20 of the Colonial Law of four (4) men to serve on the Electoral Boards.

14 voting tickets were handed in.

Elected were: 2nd Member for Christiansted Town [Canegata], and 2nd Member for Frederiksted Town [Merwin] with 12 votes respectively, 3rd Member for Christiansted Country District (Robt. W. Skeoch) with 8 votes.

3rd Member for Frederiksted Country District (M. M. Skeoch) received 7 votes, 2nd Member for Christiansted Country District (Berg) 4 votes, 1st Member for Christiansted Country District [Jessen], 1st Member for Frederiksted Country District [Fleming] and 4th Member for said District [Andersen] 3 votes respectively, 3rd Member for Christiansted Town [Alexander] and 1st Member for Frederiksted Town [Jackson] 2 votes respectively and 1st Appointed Member [Coulter] 1 vote.

As none of the other members had absolute majority vote a new free election had to take place for another member.

12 voting tickets were handed in.

3rd Member for Frederiksted Country District [M. M. Skeoch] was elected with 8 votes.

4th Member for Frederiksted Country District [Andersen] received 4 votes.
