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eration over alliances and the belief that great good would accrue from a conference between Great Britain, Japan and the United States. He insisted upon the world's great need of disarmament and the aspiration that in time to come the relations between nations would be more and more based on good will. General Smuts was especially favourable to such a conference and is also believed to have favoured the suggested postponement of the renewal of the Anglo-Japanese treaty for three months, to allow negotiations and conversations between the countries concerned. He is said to be inclined to the idea that all questions of alliance should be considered in conjunction with larger questions such as disarmament. Mr. Hughes argued in favour of a renewal of the treaty on the ground that it was better to have Japan a friend in the Pacific than an enemy.

London, June 29th.—The position of the Ismid Peninsular in Asia Minor, where the Greek and Turkish Nationalists forces are opposed to each other, is obscure, Mr. Harmsworth stated in the House of Commons today. Information received this morning, however, was that the town of Ismid had been evacuated by the Greeks and was burning, with the result that there was a great panic in the district.
