Dear Attorney Praschak:

As you may recall, several weeks ago, my office forwarded a proposal to remove soil which may be contaminated from the property occupied by my client L'Henri, Inc. We had hoped that the agency would consider our proposal and discuss with us any changes in order that a formal workplan could be prepared. To date we have not heard from your office.

For several years, my client has requested permission from the agency to remove any soil which may be contaminated from its property. However, to date, said permission has been denied by the agency. As I have explained both in conversation and in writing, my client is concerned that any contaminated soil which may exist on its property has the potential of providing an additional source of contamination to the groundwater. We, therefore, would appreciate the opportunity to discuss our proposal with your office at your earliest convenience.
