PURSUANT to authority vested in me by Section 3 of an Ordinance "To better provide for the recording of vital statistics in the Municipality of St. Croix, and for other purposes," approved June 24, 1919, the following registration districts are hereby designated and defined for the Municipality of St. Croix, to wit:

CHRISTIANSTED REGISTRATION DISTRICT comprises all the territory east of the quarter line dividing the 4th and 5th quarters to the junction with the southern quarter line of the 3rd quarter, and including all of estates Mt. Pleasant and Hermitage; thence west to the western boundary line of estate Fountain, thence north following the western boundary line of Estate Fountain and Sweet Bottom to the north shore line of the island;

FREDERIKSTED REGISTRATION DISTRICT comprises all the territory not included in the Christiansted Registration District.

Pursuant to the foregoing authority, the following appointments are hereby made, to wit:

The **CHIEF MUNICIPAL PHYSICIAN**, St. Croix, appointed as **REGISTRAR OF VITAL STATISTICS** for the Municipality of St. Croix;

The **INSPECTOR** of the **CHRISTIANSTED MUNICIPAL HOSPITAL** appointed as **LOCAL REGISTRAR** of the **CHRISTIANSTED REGISTRATION DISTRICT**;

The **INSPECTOR** of the **FREDERIKSTED MUNICIPAL HOSPITAL** appointed as **LOCAL REGISTRAR** of the **FREDERIKSTED REGISTRATION DISTRICT**;

The **CLERK** of the **CHRISTIANSTED MUNICIPAL HOSPITAL** appointed as **DEPUTY LOCAL REGISTRAR** of the **CHRISTIANSTED REGISTRATION DISTRICT**; and

The **CLERK** of the **FREDERIKSTED MUNICIPAL HOSPITAL** appointed as **DEPUTY LOCAL REGISTRAR** of the **FREDERIKSTED REGISTRATION DISTRICT**.
