GOVERNMENT OF THE VIRGIN ISLANDS
OF THE UNITED STATES ST THOMAS

Executive Order No. 24.

EXECUTIVE Order No 20 dated 11 April, 1921, is hereby revoked effective 14 November, 1921.

The sale of denatured Bay Rum without permit from the Police Department is prohibited. All provisions of Executive Order No. 9 issued 24 January, 1920, are revived except that Bay Rum permits legally issued in accordance therewith shall be returned within 24 hours to the Police Department by the vendor of the Bay Rum.

It is further provided that alcohol shall be sold only in the manner prescribed for the sale of Bay Rum.

The penalties provided by Ordinance approved 9 July, 1918, shall apply in cases of violations of this order.
