unionist not connected with the railways, and one other would represent the cooperative movement, neither body said Mr. Thomas could withhold from the men the right to strike, but it was obvious they would not strike while a matter was under discussion he was convinced the machinery proposed would insure smooth working and improve the men conditions.

London, Nov. 16th.—Almost unnoticed by the general public and ignored by the London Press, the strike of 50,000 iron moulders has been in progress since September 22nd, and a settlement appears to be as far off as ever. The dispute is acting on British industry like a creeping paralysis. Engineering works are gradually closing down for lack of essential material normally supplied by moulders. The automobile industry is particularly affected and manufacturers present at this weeks big show at the Olympia, paint a gloomy picture of the business dislocation the dispute is responsible for. It is estimated that every iron moulder on strike has thrown out of employment, three other workmen in allied engineering trades.
