Publication.

THE Government has been advised that, the United States Geographic Board, at its meeting held on December 2, 1921 and February 1, 1922, rendered the following decisions:

BARENTS BAY: Northwest of David Point, near west end St. Thomas Island, Virgin Islands. (Not Barents, Bayo de Guillaume Barents, Regis nor Willem Barentses.)

BEVERHOUTBERG HILL: (Altitude 545 feet), and old estate on summit, one-fifth mile south of Susannaberg, St. John Island, Virgin Islands. (Not Bevenhoultsberg, Beverhoubtberg, nor Beverhondsberg.)

COMPASS POINT: Low, rocky projection, opposite Rotto Cay, on southern shore St. Thomas Island, Virgin Islands.

DAVID POINT: Bluff-angle, on southern shore, 1 1/4 miles southeast of west point of St. Thomas Island, Virgin Island. (Not Coffee, David's, Pubbedam, Riks, nor Ryks Davids.)

FRANKMAN BAY: 1 mile ESE of Muhlenfels Point, south coast of St. Thomas Island, Virgin Islands. (Not Francaise, Franskmand, Fransmans, nor Frenchman.)

KRUM BAY: Deep inlet, 150 yards wide, 800 yards long, between hills at Regis and Mosquito Points, St. Thomas Island, Virgin Islands. (Not Great Krum nor Store-Krum).

MINGO CAY: Five-eighths mile long, 194 feet high, between Lovango and Grass Cay, Virgin Islands. (Not Lovango Medio, Singo, nor Zinjo.)

ROHDE BANK: 3 small coral heads, 2 fathoms deep, one-fourth mile NEW from Muhlenfels Point, St. Thomas Harbor entrance, Virgin Islands. (Not Banco de Rhode, Rhode, nor Rohdes Grund).

TRUNK BAY: 800 yards wide, and bathing beach northwest coast St. John Island, Virgin Islands. (Not Troncbay.)

TRUNK CAY: 210 yards long, 48 feet high, 80 yards from Trunk Bay beach, northwestern shore St. John Island, Virgin Islands.

CAPELLA: Group of two islands, 60 yards apart, 2 miles south of St. Thomas Island, Virgin Islands.

KRAUSE LAGOON: area of pools, channels, mudbanks, and mangrove islets, southern coast St. Croix Island, Virgin Islands. (Not Krause Krausse, nor Krusse.)

KRAUSE POINT: Near long 64° 46', southern coast St. Croix Island, Virgin Islands.
