TELEGRAMS.

ST. CROIX STATION.

Warsaw, Aug. 3rd.—The breaking off of the negotiations between the Poles and the Bolsheviks, out of which it was hoped would come an armistice and an early cessation of hostilities, was due to a misunderstanding, according to the contention of the Russian Soviet authorities in a wireless despatch received here today. The latest communication from the Soviets suggest that negotiations both for an armistice and for peace should be held at Minsk, on Wednesday. It asks that the Poles send a delegation to Minsk, invested with the necessary credentials to negotiate peace. The Poles contend it will be a physical impossibility for them to comply with this proposal while the Polish delegates are re-tracing their steps homeward from Baranovitch.

Paris, Aug. 4th.—Polish, French and British military experts at Warsaw telegraphed here last night stating that Warsaw must be evacuated within two or three days. They report that the Polish army along the Bug river, which was Warsaw's last line of defence, retreated so precipitately that they did not destroy the bridges behind them.

London, Aug. 4th.—When the Bolshevik suggested the opening of negotia-

tions at Minsk on Wednesday, they proposed in order to save time, that the Polish Govt. should notify the Russian Govt. by wireless that a courier with new credentials had been sent, says a despatch to the "Herald", the labour organ, from Christiania.

London, Aug. 4th.—The British Govt., irritated over what it believes Soviet Russia's equivocation over the British suggestion that the Russians halt at the armistice line of demarcation in Poland, and begin peace negotiations, has despatched a sharp note to the Soviet Govt. demanding an answer yes, or no, as to whether that Govt. intends to listen to the suggestion.

London, Aug. 4th.—A remarkable motion, demanding that the Govt. arrest and impeach Mr. Winston Churchill, the Secretary of State for War, at the bar of Parliament for violating the constitution by using British military resources to assist the reactionary elements in Europe to make war against Soviet Russia, without the consent of the British Parliament or people, will be submitted by the Independent Labour Party, at the annual conference of the Scottish Labour Party in Glasgow on September twenty-fourth. This announcement was made by officials of the Independent Labour Party yesterday.

"You promise true allegiance to American Sovereignty, and that means an undivided allegiance. If, wherever you happen to live, whether that be in San Francisco, New York, Chicago or Porto Rico, there is any movement looking to separation from the United States you are bound to oppose it with all your influence and with all your means, even unto death. The United States knows no divided sovereignty. One is an American or he is not an American; there is nothing between."
