NOTICE.

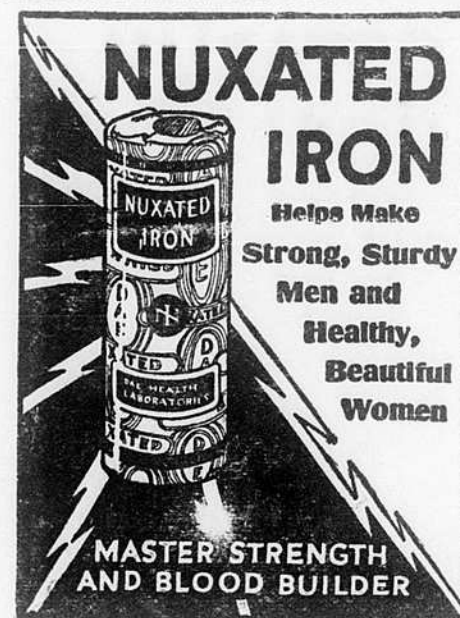
