close season, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

The use of traps to ensnare deer, hogs, goats, cattle and sheep is prohibited at all times and is punishable under the terms of this ordinance.

Sect. 5.

Any person who between June first and October thirtieth knowingly or wilfully kills, wounds or takes female sea-turtles, or knowingly or wilfully exposes or offers for sale or purchases such animal or animals, or any part of such animal or animals killed, wounded or taken or knowingly or wilfully collects sea-turtle-eggs, or knowingly or wilfully exposes or offers for sale or purchases such egg or eggs collected, within the dates above specified, which shall be known as the close season, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Sect. 6.

Any person who at any time knowingly or wilfully kills, wounds or takes female lobsters with eggs, or knowingly or wilfully exposes or offers for sale or purchases such animal or animals killed, wounded or taken shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Sect. 7.

Government shall appoint for each Quarter in this municipality an adequate number of "Game-wardens",

who after being furnished with necessary authority and properly sworn in, shall assist the Police in order that the regulations laid down in this ordinance be rigidly observed.

These appointments as game-wardens are to be unsalaried.

Sect. 8.

Because of the predatory habits of the mongoose, there will hereafter be paid by the Director of Police, the sum of 50 bits for each male and 75 bits for each female mongoose delivered, dead or alive to the Police Department: Provided that anyone breeding the mongoose for the purpose of obtaining the benefits provided by this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Sect. 9.

In the case of an offense against this ordinance any person witnessing the commission of the said offence may require the offender to give his name and address, and if such offender refuses to do so, or gives an erroneous or fictitious name or address, he shall be guilty of an additional misdemeanor and liable for double penalty.

Sect. 10.

Any person convicted of offense against this ordinance shall be liable to a fine of not less than frcs.

25.—and not exceeding frcs.125.—, and in all cases confiscation by the court of the implements used (fire-arm, trap, net, fishpot etc.)

Sect. 11.

Recognized ornithologists may, upon presentation of their credentials—provided they have obtained the necessary permission from the respective landowners—be permitted by the Government to trap, snare, capture or kill during any season wild birds of Class A. B. and C. or those not mentioned in this ordinance, as specimens for their collections and to collect their eggs.

Sect. 12.

All laws or parts of laws in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

CLASSIFICATION OF WILD BIRDS.

Class A. Humming birds, Banana birds, Crane, Coo-Coo, West Indian Robin, Mockingbird, Tern, Booby, Tropical Bird, Yellowbreast, West Indian Trush, Blackwitch, Pea Whistler, Kingfisher, Blacksmith, Sour Sop bird, West Indian Canary, Man O'War bird, Loggerhead, Chicer, Pelican, Barbados blackbird.

Class B. Wild Pigeon, Mountain Dove, Coots (red and white seal) Wood Dove, Partridge, Ground Dove, Golden Plover, Wild Ducks, Water fowl, Quail, Green Gawling.

Class C. Chicken Hawk, Killi Killi Hawk.
